“While we all await a decision from the U.S. Department of Justice on whether or not this new rule will violate the Federal Help America Vote Act, I do believe it is a small step in the right direction.

The rule will allow voters to cast a provisional ballot on Election Day as long as they can produce their drivers license number by the next day. This should help stem the growing tide of voter fraud in Wisconsin.

Unfortunately, Jim Doyle remains the number one obstacle to clean and fair elections in Wisconsin. Three times Jim Doyle has vetoed a Photo ID requirement – despite the fact that 80 percent of Wisconsin residents support it. Without this common sense protection, legally cast ballots may be cancelled out by fraud.

It's too bad the State Elections Board refused to educate the voters of Wisconsin and instead buried their news in the legal section of only one state newspaper. Wisconsin voters deserve to know that when they enter a voting booth this fall, their vote will count and not be cancelled out by fraud.

Because of the actions of Doyle's appointees to the State Elections Board and the vetoes of Jim Doyle of a sensible Photo ID requirement, they do not have that guarantee.

The surest way to protect the integrity of our elections is by electing Mark Green as our next Governor. Mark Green will sign a Photo ID requirement and protect the voting rights of everyone in Wisconsin.
