RESULTS OF TODAY'S MILWAUKEE COUNTY BOARD MEETING

*County Board overrides County Executive veto of stimulus funds policy
Veto of contract extension for Task Force consultant sustained*

- 16-2 (**veto overridden**) (No Cesarz, Rice) to override the County Executive's veto of a resolution affirming Milwaukee County's policy in pursuit of stimulus funding from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act for the benefit of Milwaukee County citizens.
- 9-9 (**veto sustained**) (Noes Borkowski, Cesarz, DeBruin, Jursik, Larson, Rice, Sanfelippo, Schmitt, Weishan) to override the County Executive's veto of a resolution authorizing and approving an amended contract extension through April, 2009 to retain outside consultant assistance from the Lazarus Group, LLC, to the Milwaukee County Task Force on Work Reform for Men, to provide more focus on equitable employment opportunities in work reform, particularly for fathers and other males of color, and issue a request for proposals for consulting services to the Task Force.
- 13-5 (Noes Borkowski, Cesarz, Rice, Sanfelippo, Schmitt) to **lay over** a resolution/ordinance to amend Milwaukee County General Ordinances as it pertains to the appointment and supervision of the Superintendent of the House of Correction.
- 13-5 (Noes Borkowski, Cesarz, Clark, Rice, Sanfelippo) to adopt a policy statement endorsing the continued operation of the Farm and Fish Hatchery programs located at the House of Correction as programs of overriding value for the residents of Milwaukee County.
