Lieutenant Governor Lawton to Unveil Art Exhibit in State Capitol Celebrating Earth Day

Lieutenant Governor Barbara Lawton will host a reception in her Capitol office to unveil the latest in a series of art exhibits highlighting the diverse talents of Wisconsin's arts community. The reception will be held from 4:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. on Monday, April 5, 2004. The public is invited.

The new exhibit, "Water Works" by artist and environmentalist Ken Halfmann, will be on display from April 5th through May 30th. Halfmann's photography draws our focus to water as an essential, yet fragile resource. The exhibit launches Lt. Governor Lawton's observations of Earth Day this year.

Lieutenant Governor Lawton gives the wall space in her Capitol office over to Wisconsin artists to rotating art exhibits of Wisconsin arts works.
