Law Enforcement (LE)



Victim Chooses to Report to LE <u>or</u> Mandatory Reporting Applies



Collect kit from hospital w/in **72 hours** of being contacted by SANE



Send kit to Crime Lab w/in 14 days



Kit returned to LE from Crime Lab (post-testing or if not tested)



LE retains kit for:

50 years; Statute of limitations expires; <u>or</u> Offender finishes serving sentence, whichever is longer

Victim Later Reports to LE



LE notifies Crime Lab that victim has now reported the sexual assault

Victim Chooses Not
to Report and

Contact law enforcement within **24 hours** to collect kit

Send sexual assault kit to Crime Lab within **72 hours**





Law enforcement collects kit within **72 hours** of being contacted

Stored at Crime Lab for **10**years
